Subject: Promotion from SDE (T) to DE/AGM-regarding.

Respected madam,

Your kind attention is invited to the seniority list No.6&7 of SDE (T) which were finalized as per judgment dated 25.8.2009 of Hon'ble CAT, Chandigarh. The same judgment was also upheld by Hon'ble the three Judges bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India comprising Hon'ble Chief Justice of India.

However, it has come to our notice that a related matter was argued before Hon'ble two judges bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to get a **reverse order**. And now there is demand from some groups to revise the existing seniority list No.6&7 on the basis of this interim order of Hon'ble two judges bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, over ruling the Hon'ble three bench orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Whether the interim judgment of Hon'ble two judges bench is legally applicable over Hon'ble three judges bench order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, is a legal matter. However, we understand that even if there are some new

facts in the matter, BSNL should fairly try to apprise the Hon'ble Supreme Court and get it referred to the three judges' bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Though, SEWA is not party in this matter before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India; however, interest of a large numbers of our members is directly connected in the matter.

If the seniority list 6 & 7 of SDE (T) are revised as per the interim order of Hon'ble two judges bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, a large number of SC/ST executives would displace from existing position and move down to the bottom of the list. Such situation would be highly detrimental to the large numbers of SC/ST members of SEWA.

So, it is our humble request and submission that promotion orders should be issued in accordance to the existing Seniority list prepared as per the Hon'ble CAT, Chandigarh judgment, also upheld by Hon'ble three bench judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
